Proposal information

1. This project will bring grade school children to Jill's Farm to help them make the direct connection between animal nutrition and welfare and their own diet and health. This will support lifelong healthy diet choices. Activities will include storytelling, drawing and visiting where the animals live.
 - a. Some topics to cover: grass fed cows for healthier milk. The elimination of antibiotics from animal feed to reduce infections in people. The importance of free ranging rather than confinement feeding to make happier and healthier animals.
 - b. We believe that learning about healthy farm animals will translate into lifelong healthy diet choices.
 - c. Project dates will be during the summer when the weather is better for outdoor activities and will be determined in collaboration with the school teacher or camp counselor. Depending on availability of children and their teacher or counselor, Jill's Farm would welcome one to three, two-hour visits to the Farm per month, for three months.
 - d. Project budget:
 - \$2,000 to create safe visiting areas for the children to observe the animals.
 - \$800 for art supplies
 - \$1,000 training of volunteers and curriculum development
 - \$600 Vehicle rentals
 - Amount requested from Granny's \$4,400
